

# 2021 HOME RUN PASO ROBLES CABERNET SAUVIGNON

## THE REGION

Paso Robles is one of California's most dynamic wine regions, known for its warm days, cool nights, and diverse soils—ideal conditions for growing world-class Cabernet Sauvignon. The wide diurnal temperature shift helps grapes develop ripe, concentrated fruit flavors while preserving acidity and structure. The region's inland location also ensures long, sunny growing seasons that consistently produce bold, full-bodied wines with rich tannins and aging potential.

## THE WINE

A bold and inviting bouquet of ripe blackberries, cassis, and dark cherries leads the way, layered with hints of blackcurrant and plum. As the wine opens, notes of cedar, vanilla, and baking spices from oak aging emerge, complemented by a touch of dark chocolate, tobacco, and graphite for added complexity.

Rich and full-bodied, the first sip reveals luscious dark fruit flavors—black cherry, blackcurrant, and boysenberry—balanced by savory undertones of espresso, leather, and dried herbs. The wine's structure is defined by firm yet velvety tannins, which provide depth and elegance, while subtle notes of mocha, clove, and toasted oak add warmth and complexity.

The finish is long and lingering, with layers of dark fruit, cocoa, and spice slowly fading into a smooth, well-integrated oak character. A touch of minerality and fresh acidity keeps the wine balanced, leaving a lasting impression of sophistication and power.

## PERFECT PAIRINGS:

Hearty dishes like braised short ribs, rosemary garlic lamb chops, or wild mushroom risotto enhance the wine's bold flavors, making each sip even more memorable.
